

FACT SHEET

ReConnect is a free computer recycling program for residents of Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont.

- The program is intended to raise awareness of the importance of responsible computer disposal and to give residents a free, convenient way to recycle used computers.
- ReConnect is jointly managed by Dell and Goodwill Industries of Northern New England.
- The program diverts used computers and computer equipment from landfills and educates residents on the importance of proper computer recycling.

Significance of program to the region:

- Computers contain environmentally-sensitive materials. These materials can be safely removed or recycled, but only if the computers are kept out of landfills in the first place. ReConnect provides an environmentally responsible solution for computer recycling.
- Consumers can drop-off computer equipment at any Goodwill location throughout Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont.
- Goodwill is the first non-profit in northern New England to recycle all brands of used computers free of charge.
- All proceeds from the recycled computer equipment will support the mission of Goodwill to assist people in overcoming barriers to social and economic independence.

What happens to the donated computer equipment?

- Goodwill accepts and sorts the donated computer equipment. The equipment will be responsibly recycled through Dell's Asset Recovery Services program.

How to recycle an unwanted computer:

- Drop off computer equipment at any of Goodwill's 25 retail stores or 6 Attended Donation Centers throughout Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont. (Specific locations and contact information is provided on the reverse side of this document).
- There is no charge for dropping off a computer. Any brand of used computer is accepted.
- Customers are responsible for removing data from their hard drives. Neither Goodwill nor Dell is liable for data removal or protection.
- Customers may be able to deduct the value of the computer for tax purposes. Goodwill provides donors with a donation receipt at the time of donation. Customers are encouraged to check with their tax advisors for more information.
